

Hurricane Fence Expands High-Security Fencing for Data Center Sector

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Hurricane Fence, a Class A licensed fencing contractor with more than 30 years of critical infrastructure fencing experience in the Mid-Atlantic region, has established a commercial division in Northern Virginia to serve the area's expanding data center and government security fencing market.

Northern Virginia is home to the largest concentration of data center infrastructure in the country, with new facilities under development across Loudoun, Prince William, and Fairfax counties. The perimeter security requirements for this class of facility go well beyond what most commercial fence contractors are equipped to meet. These systems require anti-climb barrier specifications designed to prevent unauthorized access and scaling, crash-rated vehicle barrier systems designed to stop vehicles at specific weights and speeds, and compatibility with perimeter intrusion detection equipment. Federal projects must also conform to Anti-Terrorism Force Protection standards, a set of physical security requirements governed by the Department of Defense.

Hurricane Fence has worked in this category for more than three decades, serving military installations, government campuses, and commercial security facilities across multiple states on both the east coast and central United States. Non-disclosure agreements are standard in this sector, and the company does not name specific clients or project sites for this work. That record has earned the company an A+ rating from the Better Business Bureau, an American Fence Association Blue Ribbon Company designation, and the Highwire Gold Safety Award and ConstructSecure Gold Safety Award in Division 32, an exterior improvement category that includes fence and related site work.

The company's in-house gate operator and access control division, which Hurricane Fence describes as the only one of its kind operated by a Virginia-based fence contractor, handles the access control side of each installation in-house, without a separate subcontractor. The gate team holds the IDEA Certified Automated Gate Systems Designer credential, an accreditation for automated gate system design professionals, as well

as Certified Automatic Gate Operator Installer and Certified Gate Attendant Designer designations. Hurricane Fence has installed K4, K8, and K12 crash-rated barrier systems, which are rated by the weight and speed of the vehicle they are designed to stop, along with M30 and M50 impact-rated systems, across projects in the eastern United States.

"We have been doing this work for a long time, across military bases, government facilities, and data center campuses," said Dennis Sulser, owner of Hurricane Fence. "Northern Virginia has the largest concentration of that kind of work in the country, and we are bringing the same team, the same certifications, and the same standards to it that we have always applied to this class of project."
