Many individuals who initially seek help for addiction discover underlying mental health conditions that have contributed to their substance use patterns. Conversely, those seeking mental health treatment often benefit from concurrent addiction support.

"The stigma around both mental health and addiction has decreased significantly in recent years, leading more people to seek comprehensive treatment," noted an Anchor Point representative. "We're seeing individuals and families who understand that effective treatment means addressing all aspects of a person's health, not just the most visible symptoms."

Anchor Point specializes in connecting Philadelphia residents with treatment programs for various substances, including fentanyl, heroin, alcohol, cocaine, methamphetamine, and the increasingly prevalent xylazine.
